chele Caputo (George) and Federico Franchi (Ringo) have played with the great names of Italian pop and will not disappoint with a show that runs through the memories with performances faithful to the original, rediscovering the enthusiasm and positivity of the Swinging '60s. Come and rock n' roll and sing along accompanied by a 4-course dinner (price CHF 155.- including wine and drinks).

Doors open at 6.30pm and the start is at 7.30pm. Bring your friends and why not take a table (round) together seating 9 or 10 people – should be a lot of fun and a very memorable evening!
